CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, Most major electronic messaging applications  
2 provide a number of flag emojis, including that of the Republic of  
3 Chile, but the official flag of Texas, also known as the Lone Star  
4 Flag, is not included in the selection; and

5           WHEREAS, All too often, the Chilean flag emoji is used as a  
6 substitute for the Lone Star Flag in text messaging and on social  
7 media platforms; the Chilean flag proudly represents its country  
8 but, despite its similarity to the Texas flag, it does not represent  
9 the State of Texas; and

10           WHEREAS, The colors of the Chilean flag depict sky, snow, and  
11 blood spilled while fighting for freedom, but the blue, white, and  
12 red of the Lone Star Flag stand for the Texan values of loyalty,  
13 purity, and bravery; and

14           WHEREAS, The single star of the Chilean flag, positioned in a  
15 blue canton, has been seen by some as a guide to progress and honor,  
16 while others have interpreted it to symbolize the powers of Chile's  
17 government; and

18           WHEREAS, The independent Lone Star of Texas, situated in a  
19 blue left panel, represents all of Texas and stands for our unity as  
20 one for God, State, and Country, according to Section [3100.152\(d\)](#),  
21 Government Code; additionally, the five points of the Lone Star  
22 have been said to represent the characteristics of a good Texas  
23 citizen: fortitude, loyalty, righteousness, prudence, and  
24 broadmindedness; and

1           WHEREAS, The Lone Star Flag has a grand history, starting  
2 with its adoption as the third flag of the Republic of Texas by  
3 President Mirabeau B. Lamar and the Texas Congress in 1839, and just  
4 as our flag could never fully embody the country of Chile, neither  
5 can the Chilean flag inspire feelings of pride and passion in the  
6 heart of a true Texan; now, therefore, be it

7           RESOLVED, That the 85th Legislature of the State of Texas  
8 hereby reject the notion that the Chilean flag, although it is a  
9 nice flag, can in any way compare to or be substituted for the  
10 official state flag of Texas and urge all Texans not to use the  
11 Republic of Chile flag emoji in digital forums when referring to the  
12 Lone Star Flag of the great State of Texas.
